We, taxpayers of Waterville Estates, are in support of Campton Mountain in its full capacity. We believe snowmaking brought tremendous value to not only the ski area but the entire Waterville Estates Community. It is our understanding, the 60 off-peak hours of snowmaking had no effect on the water system and would like to voice our support for snowmaking in the 2019-2020 season. The owners and all of the amenities are what make our community great. Our understanding is snowmaking was run on a trial basis leading into the 2018-2019 season and the trial was very successful. We are hopeful, 60 hours of water usage/snowmaking will be considered this year until the infrastructure is in place for a permanent solution.

Manmade snow is much more resilient than natural snow. This resiliency provides more than an extended season; it allows for much better conditions throughout the entire year. The increased snow depth allows for gates to be placed at proper depth for children, who wish to ski/ride through them, as well as events like the fun race. Additionally, the extended season provides a greater sense of community to the Estates during the winter months.

We appreciate all the hard work done by the Waterville Estates Staff and each of the people who volunteer their time to make our community a better place. We support all ongoing efforts to improve each aspect of the Estates and hope Campton Mountain snowmaking will be part of the 2019-2020 season and beyond.
